

Arte Masterclasses 2022

Terms and conditions

1. The order of applications decides about participation in masterclasses.
2. A maximum of 40 participants can take part in the course.
3. As part of the fee paid, the organizer provides participation in the course, accommodation from 8 to 14 May (6 nights) and dinner on the first day, full board on the following days as well as breakfast on the last day.
4. The Arte Masterclasses are intended for people over 16 years of age. Organizers are not responsible for minors.
5. The organizer is not responsible for the belongings, health and deeds of the participants. We suggest participants have up-to-date medical and accident insurance.
6. The organizer reserves the right to register photo / video for archival and promotional purposes.
7. Photographing and video recording of classes and concerts is allowed only with the consent of the lecturer.
8. Application in the form of an online form completed by the participant, accepted and qualified by the organizer, obliges the applicant to participate in the Masterclasses. Failure to show up at the workshop after prior submission and qualification will result in covering the full cost.
